ROHS DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY HILGENBERG GMBH

- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Lead glass processed by us is conform to RoHS, if it used for one the purposes listed in Article 4, Annex III and Annex IV and is therefore falling under the respective exemptions. Securing the conformity of the glass with respect to RoHS is therefore in the responsibility of our customers.
